They explore the possibilities offered by the spaces at Goethe-Institut / Max Mueller Bhavan Kolkata: using surfaces for video projections, angles and corners for body movements floors for proclaiming texts by philosopher Gilles Deleuze, writer Peter Handke and novelist Gao Xingjian. To extend the space for interactions, to widen the time for relations, and, by doing so, to question, to enhance, that is to say to keep alive and creative, the ways Trimukhi Platform operates, daily rehearsals are open to all and a workshop about strategies to combine multiple and diverse presences is proposed during two days— activities that require to learn a bit of the Santhali language and few steps of tribal group dance. That is to say: other places to be "displaced"
